However, since the plantations of Mr. Ibu Nasti as a whole were in violation of the NDPE policy, we stopped procurement from these plantations as of October 18th 2022.

Nia Yulided Bersaudara has been listed on the no-purchase list since 2019. •However, it was found that FFB was deliverered from PT. Nia Yulided Bersaudara to PT. Bumi Sama Ganda, a mill linked to NISSIN supply chain, through the sub-agent "RAM UD MakmurJaya" in a period spanning November 1st 2022 to November 14th 2022. •Since their actions are against the NDPE policy, transactions with RAM UD MakmurJaya have also been suspended. *FFB: fresh fruit bunches
3	Bumitama Agri, Harita Group/Gunung Makmur, Bukit Tunggal Jaya, Bukit Belaban Jaya	Rainforest Action Network (RAN)	Jan-2023	Allegation of noncompliance with regards to land rights and NDPE policy in the Long Isun community	While NISSIN has no direct relationships with Bumitama Agri, a palm oil producer part of the Harita Group, we confirmed the facts with our business partners in response to this report. In the past, there was a possibility that NISSIN sourced palm oil from their mills, but there are no ongoing transactions at present.

Global Sawit Semesta" in 2024. •After an investigation conducted through our direct supplier, it is confirmed that PT. Global Sawit Semesta has suspended all the transactions between their supplier "UD Iqbal Jaya", who is allegedly sourcing from the Rawa Singkil Wildlife Reserve, effective 25 October 2024. •Our supplier will maintain oversight of PT. Global Sawit Semesta, which has a traceability to plantation system in place, to ensure adherence to traceability and sustainable sourcing standards, while NISSIN will also monitor their activities through a satellite monitoring system.
